Information for European Solidarity Corps beneficiaries

Version 2: August 2019

If you receive European Solidarity Corps funding, you must acknowledge the European Union's support by using the European emblem and appropriate wording when communicating about your project. This applies to projects across all European Solidarity Corps actions.

Only projects directly approved for funding can use the emblem in their communication. Organisations who have not received European Solidarity Corps funding are not allowed to apply the emblem and specific wording on their communication.

Where to use the emblem

- on all communications or documents related to your European Solidarity Corps funded project such as promotional items and materials (e.g. leaflets, posters, newsletters, websites, press releases)*;
- on any communication made by the partnership as a whole, or as an individual project partner;
- at events and on presentation slides;
- alongside other organisational and/or project logos as outlined in your grant agreement;
- on your project's website.
